**INTERVIEW THE ECONOMIST WHO'S MAKING ECONOMIC
AND POLITICAL ISSUES ACCESSIBLE TO THE GENERAL
PUBLIC**

Dr. Donald J. Boudreaux consumes news from countless outlets daily and what he reads often leaves him shaking his head – or laughing out loud. The professor of economics at George Mason University is concerned about the public's – and media's – lack of understanding of important everyday economic and political issues and he works hard to counter falsities that can threaten a free and prosperous nation.

Dr. Boudreaux writes more than 400 letters annually to editors, producers and journalists countering shaky facts, faulty reasoning and intellectual dishonesty; and recently compiled a select number of them in his new book, *Hypocrites and Half-Wits: A Daily Dose of Sanity from Café Hayek*. With the 2012 election cycle and its resultant rhetoric at a fever pitch, Boudreaux's pen has been working overtime.

In an enlightening, non-partisan interview, Boudreaux will cut through the rubbish to inform listeners about the truths behind important issues including:

- Why does free trade not raise unemployment here at home?"
- Is a U.S. trade deficit *good* for Americans?
- Does government economic intervention *really* help everyday Americans?
- Won't an economy built on greed malfunction serving only the "1%"?

Dr. Donald J. Boudreaux is a professor of economics and former chair of the Department of Economics at George Mason University. A regular columnist with *The Wall Street Journal*, Dr. Boudreaux also writes about the events of the day at his popular blog Café Hayek and submits more than 400 letters to editors, journalists and producers at major American media annually, disputing misreporting and intellectual dishonest.
